



Oven Temp 350 3 dozen Kid friendly

Ingredients

2 cups all-purpose flour
1 cup salted butter, softened (2 sticks)
1/2 powdered sugar

Preparations

Pre-heat oven to 350 degrees. Prepare one 3-inch round cookie stamp and one 3 inch round cookie cutter (biscuit cutter) Ungreased baking pan or parchment paper lined.

In a large bowl cream butter and powdered sugar until light and fluffy. Add flour, mix till dough melds together. Wrap in plastic and chill for at least 15 minutes.

Knead dough for 2 minutes, roll out dough onto lightly floured surface. 1/4 inch thick. Dust cookie stamp lightly with flour and press onto dough, press as many cookie stamps as rolled area provides. Cut with (biscuit cutter) over stamped impressions, lift with a spatula onto baking pan. Repeat until dough is used up

Bake in hot oven (350 degrees) for 18-20 minutes or until edges are lightly brown. Cool 2 minutes and transfer to wire rack for cooling.

For fun, Apply sprinkles before baking.

If you do not have a cookie stamp, be creative, the bottom of a patterned glass or a criss-cross fork design would delight the eye as well.
